Buying Fresh & Local Makes Sense . . .

because the health of our farms, community, and environment are connected!

Economy

Spending locally keeps money in the community, supports small farms, and helps protect farmland for future generations.

Taste

Locally grown food is bred for taste—not durability—so it's fresher, picked at peak ripeness, and full of real flavor.

Community

Buying local strengthens connections between farmers and neighbors, preserves farmland, and keeps regional food traditions alive.

Health

Buying local supports farms that prioritize healthy soil—leading to cleaner water, better air quality, and more nutrient-dense food.

Environment

Locally grown food reduces transportation emissions, supports biodiversity, and promotes healthier soil through sustainable farming practices.

LOCAL FOODS GLOSSARY

The **Local Food System (LFS)** describes the network of producers, distributors, retailers, and consumers involved in producing and consuming food within a specific geographic region. We define our LFS as products primarily grown, distributed, and consumed in the Greater Lehigh Valley region or within Lehigh, Northampton, and Berks Counties.

AGRITOURISM: Opportunities for consumers to experience agriculture first-hand through fun and educational activities like farm tours, Pick Your Own (or U-Pick) produce, seasonal events, wine tastings, holiday markets, and more! This allows farmers to diversify their income streams, especially during colder months. Get out on the farm and experience the wonders of local agriculture!

HEIRLOOM: Open-pollinated varieties of fruits, vegetables, or livestock breeds whose genetic lines have been maintained and passed down by gardeners and farmers for generations and are prized for their unique characteristics like flavor, appearance, historical significance and biodiversity.

HORMONE-FREE: All animals have naturally occurring hormones, but this term indicates that animals have been raised without the use of artificial hormones, commonly used in livestock production to promote growth. Hormone-free practices aim to reduce potential health risks associated with hormone residues in food. Federal law prohibits the use of additional hormones in all pork and poultry.

INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT (IPM): A sustainable and ecological approach to managing pests (undesired/harmful plants, bugs, and other organisms) that utilizes a multi-disciplinary understanding of crop-pest relationships, establishes an acceptable economic threshold for pest populations and requires regular monitoring and evaluation of IPM strategies used.

NON-GMO OR GMO-FREE: Indicates that products are free from genetically modified organisms (GMOs) or organisms whose genetic material has been altered in a way that does not occur naturally through mating or natural recombination. Arguments against GMO products include concerns about potential risks associated with health and the environment, like biodiversity loss. On the other hand, proponents of GMOs argue

that they can increase crop yields, reduce pesticide use, and help address global food security issues.

NO-SPRAY/PESTICIDE-FREE: Indicates that crops have been grown without the use of synthetic pesticides or herbicides. This practice promotes environmental sustainability and reduces exposure to potentially harmful chemicals.

NO- OR REDUCED-TILL: Farming method that avoids disturbing the soil through tillage, helping to improve soil health, reduce erosion, and sequester carbon.

PASTURED/PASTURE-RAISED: Indicates that animals have access to pasture for grazing and exercise, promoting animal welfare and producing meat with distinct flavor and nutritional benefits. As the saying goes, 'We are what our meat eats,' underscoring the importance of the quality of animal feed in the overall nutritional value of the meat.

"**Grass-Fed**" is another commonly associated term that refers to animals that eat freshly grazed pasture during the growing season and stored grasses (hay or grass silage) during the winter month or drought conditions.

REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE: Farming approach that recognizes the interdependent relationship between soil, plants, and animals and aims to rebuild soil health, enhance biodiversity, and mitigate climate change. This approach recognizes the importance of animals like pasture-raised cattle to the health of soil microbiology and ecosystem diversity. **Biodynamic Agriculture** and **Permaculture** are common terms for similar holistic approaches to food production that work with nature, not against it.

ROTATIONAL GRAZING: Grazing management technique that involves moving livestock between different pastures to optimize forage growth, prevent overgrazing, and improve soil health.

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE: Farming practices that prioritize environmental stewardship, economic viability, and social equity, recognizing the interdependence of these factors for long-term resilience and the well-being of both present and future generations.

USE ONLY (AND BEYOND) ORGANIC PRACTICES: Indicates that while not certified organic, a farm follows organic principles in its farming methods. This label is often used by small-scale producers who may not pursue formal organic certification but still prioritize organic and sustainable farming practices.

VALUE-ADDED PRODUCT: Refers to raw agricultural products that have been processed or transformed in some way to increase their value and/or shelf life, such as jams, sauces, jerky, and baked goods. These products often use locally sourced ingredients and support small-scale producers. See our *Specialty Product Producer* partners for examples of ways farm fresh products are transformed into tasty food and drinks!

VINE-RIPENED/TREE RIPENED: Describes fruits or vegetables that have been allowed to ripen naturally on the vine or tree, resulting in superior flavor, texture, and nutritional quality. Our local farmers harvest their food at peak ripeness and distribute it directly to you. This practice is far healthier for both you and the environment. Most produce sold in big-box grocery stores is harvested before peak ripeness and artificially ripened using preservatives and sold to you after many days and thousands of miles traveled from its origin farm.

Curious to learn more about growing practices, agriculture, and food? Ask our local farmers! They would love to connect with you.



ANTIBIOTIC-FREE: In some cases, antibiotics are fed to healthy animals such as cows, hogs, sheep and chickens to prevent disease and stimulate growth. "No antibiotics" implies that a farmer does not administer antibiotics to their animals. Some farmers will use antibiotics only to treat sick animals. All meat must be tested for the presence of antibiotics before it can be sold for consumption.

CERTIFIED ORGANIC: In the US, use of the term "organic" is restricted to certified organic producers. The National Organic Program (NOP) administers the standards, managed in accordance with the Organic Foods Production Act (OFPA). Certification is handled by state, non-profit and private agencies that have USDA approval. Some farmers meet and/or exceed certification standards, but are not certified for a variety of reasons including cost, consumer interest, etc.- See "Use Only Organic Practices" for more.

Regenerative Farming: 5 Principles



1 Minimize Soil Disturbance

Avoid or reduce tillage to protect soil structure, retain carbon, and preserve beneficial microorganisms essential for soil health.



2 Maintain Soil Cover

Keep the soil covered year-round with cover crops, crop residues, or mulch to prevent erosion, conserve moisture, and suppress weeds.



3 Keep Living Roots in the Soil

Grow plants or cover crops throughout the year to feed soil microbes, promote nutrient cycling, and build organic matter.



4 Integrate Livestock

Mimic natural prairielands through managed grazing and animal integration to recycle nutrients, stimulate plant growth, and close the loop between crops and livestock.



5 Maximize Biodiversity

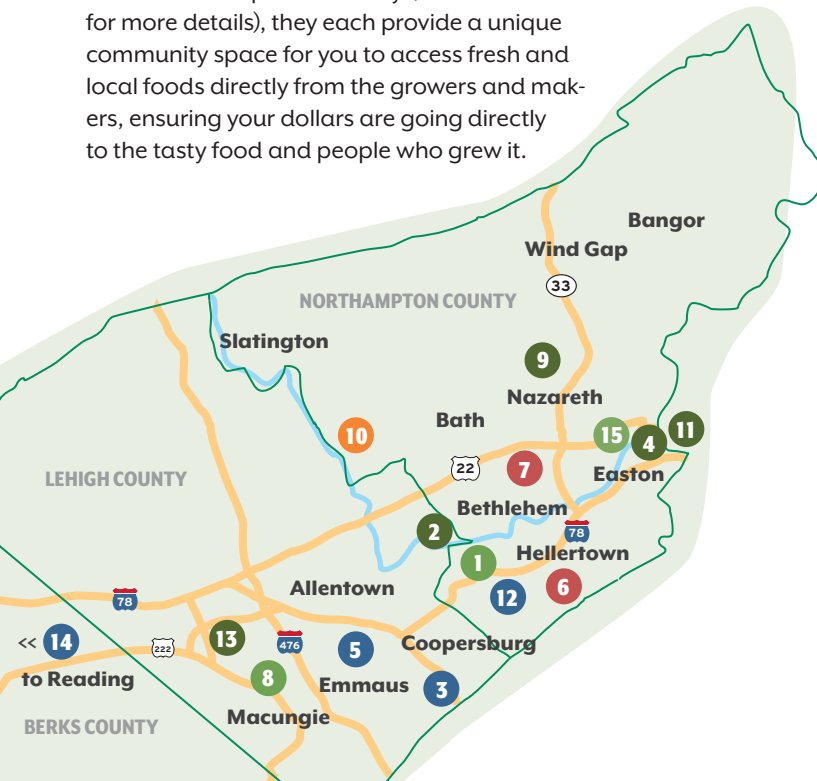
Integrate a variety of crops, livestock, and native plants to enhance ecosystem diversity, improve pest control, and strengthen resilience.

What is a Producer-Only Farmers' Market?

A producer-only farmers' market is a public and recurring assembly of farmers or their representatives selling the food that they produced directly to consumers. Though not all of our markets are considered producer-only (see our website for more details), they each provide a unique community space for you to access fresh and local foods directly from the growers and makers, ensuring your dollars are going directly to the tasty food and people who grew it.
